Congratulations to Safia, Ella E, Elsie, Alex, Reggie and Harry who were awarded with Star Status this week!



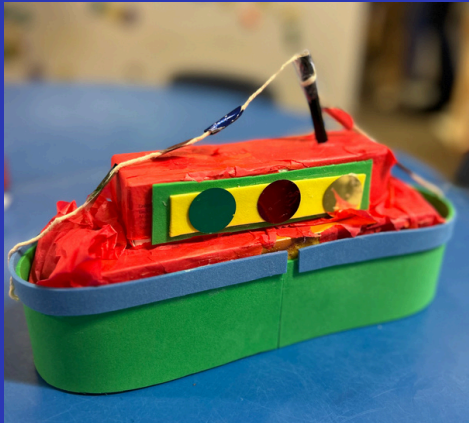
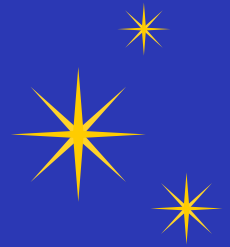
## GOLDEN TICKET WINNERS

This week on our Census Day, we gave out golden tickets. The winners were Alice, Elijah, Iroh, Archie, Larosa and Reef and they received some new books!

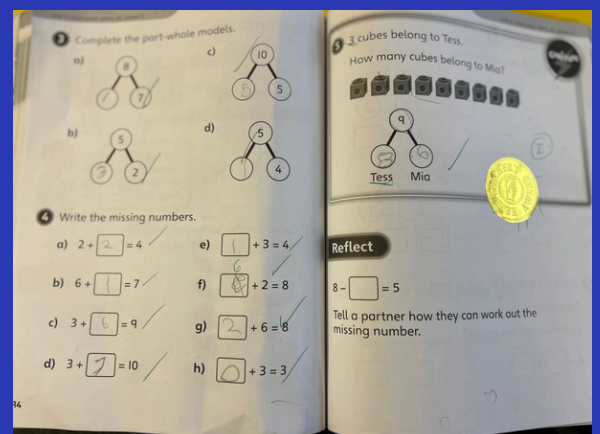

# Young Voices 2026!



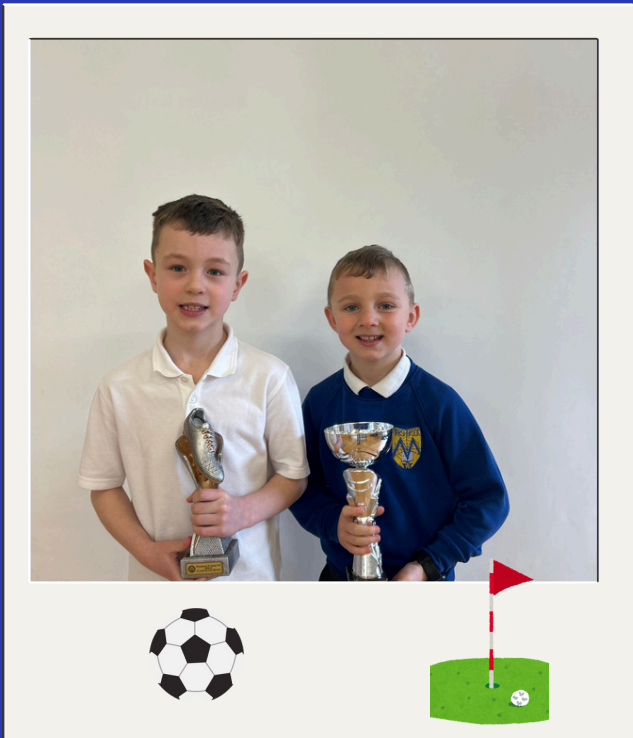
